- Know the roles and responsibilities of a work at height - *manager, operative and rescuer*
- Be aware of emergency procedures under Work at Height Regulations

SO WHAT DOES THIS MEAN...

This half day course will teach your team the regulations in an easily understandable way, where questions can be asked and advice freely given to help your team determine if the space is actually deemed as "work at height" under the regulations.

Whether or not it is truly working at height, a suitable risk assessment and some control measures to protect those around you can be a good idea anyway.

For example, signage to inform people, a record where people are working and tethers prevent dropped tools – even on safe working platforms, items drop over barriers!
